Overview

At Marathon Petroleum Corporation (MPC) we're working to enhance life's possibilities. Our Anacortes refinery is located approximately 70 miles north of Seattle on the Puget Sound, with a total crude oil capacity of 119,000 barrels per calendar day (bpcd). The refinery processes Canadian and domestic crude from North Dakota and Alaska North Slope, and international crudes to manufacture gasoline, distillates, heavy fuel oil and propane. These products are distributed through pipeline connected terminals and MPC's marine terminal via ships and barges.
